



# GENERAL MANAGER'S CORNER

# From the Desk of the General Manager...

During my years of working in the Property Management field I have found it helpful, to Homeowners and Residents, to include a part of the Governing Documents in the newsletter. The following are excerpts from the Community's Architectural Guidelines which may help in complying with the Covenants of the Southbridge Community Association.

#### <u>Parking in Visitor Parking</u> <u>Spaces</u>

The Association has received numerous complaints concerning vehicles parked in the visitor parking spaces in



the townhome sections. Each property is only allowed two (2) assigned parking spaces. The Reserved Parking Space Assignment Plan clearly states, "Visitor

parking spaces are designated for visitor parking ONLY." Households with more than two (2) vehicles are to park their extra household vehicles off the property or in overflow areas within the property. Continuous violation will result in the towing of your vehicle. If you are having visitors, a visitor pass will be issued by the association office during normal business hours. You must provide the make, model, and plate number of the vehicle. A parking pass will be issued for a period not to exceed seven (7) days. If visitors come after the association office has closed, please contact the community patrol at (703) 880-6360 and they will issue a temporary visitor pass valid for that date only. You will be advised to contact the association office at (703) 221-7716 during working hours to be issued a current visitor pass. Please contact the office at the number referenced above if you have any questions or need additional information.

Article 8.2(n) of the Declarations for Southbridge on the Potomac states, regulations that pertain to vehicles. Please see highlights below:



No junk, derelict vehicle or other vehicle on which current registration

plates and current county and state inspection permits are not displayed shall be kept upon any portion of the Common Area or any portion of a Lot visible from the Common Area or another Lot.

Vehicle repairs and storage of vehicles are not permitted.

Design Review Guidelines, Adherence, Rules, Fines.....What do they all mean? I could of course simply bore you with the standard, from the book answer:

"The legal documents for the Southbridge Community Association contain covenants, including those pertaining to architectural controls. Legally, these covenants are a part of the deed for each home and are binding upon all initial homeowners and their successors in ownership, irrespective of whether or not these owners are familiar with such covenants. The primary purpose of design covenants is to maintain environmental and architectural design standards for the entire community."

#### Yawn!!!! What the heck does that mean?

If you are like me that was my initial reaction to the "legalese" when I read it as well. I found myself asking a very simple question: Can I erect a 50 foot replica of the Statue of Liberty in my back yard or not? Short answer of course is, NO! But, when it came time to install a fence, I had to figure out what I could and couldn't do. That, my fellow residents is the purpose of the covenants committee and the Design Review Guidelines! Patriotic as I am, I sure would not want to buy a house that was next to a replica of Lady Liberty, nor would I want to live next to a tribute to "Carhenge" (Google that one sometime if you get bored).

The best way I can break it down is this, the Design Review Guidelines and the Covenants Committee are in place to protect YOUR investment. We want to ensure that Southbridge Community Association remains a desirable community, and we want to protect that "Curb Appeal" that draws people here, to buy, and to stay! Without it, a carnival of derelict cars, 2 week old trash toters, and tribute statues would become the new "Welcome to Southbridge" sign. You can imagine the effect that would have on the value of your investment.

As residents we all must do our part to ensure that we remain a competitive community, one that stays at the top of the list when people are looking to purchase a home. In order to do that, take a second and familiarize yourself with the Guidelines, available at <a href="http://southbridgeva.us">http://southbridgeva.us</a> or from the main office. You may be surprised at some of the information in there. Make sure when you are going to make any changes or improvements to your property you keep in mind the effect it will have on the overall community; let's call it the "Lady Liberty Effect". Also, make sure you are keeping up with your property as well, not only does it make our community great, it could be the difference between For Sale and Sold, for you or your neighbor!

Finally, get involved, stop by the main office, talk to the ladies there, they don't bite! Join the covenants, or any of the other committees, or at the very least, report any violations you may see to the main office. That is often the first step in fixing any existing issues. #### Online Police Reporting Now Available

PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA . . . The Prince William County Police Department has added a new online crime/incident reporting capability to its website:

www.pwcgov.org/police. This online police reporting system provides a convenient option for the public to file reports for certain types of non-emergency incidents that occurred within the Prince William County Police Department's jurisdiction.

"The implementation of online crime reporting by victims is a significant step in efficiency for the Police Department and for the public," said Police Chief Charlie T. Deane. "The new system enables individuals to save time reporting certain types of crimes and reduces administrative duties for the police officers, allowing them more time for investigations and other duties."

He added that the public will now have more flexibility in reporting certain types of crimes. "We are pleased to implement this enhancement of service," Chief Deane said.

#### Is online reporting right for you? It is if:

- The crime/incident you're reporting is not an emergency (for emergencies, please call 9-1-1).
- The crime/incident occurred in Prince William County (e.g., not City of Manassas or City of Manassas Park).
- You do not know who committed the crime/incident (e.g., there are no known suspects).
- You are 18 years old, or older.
- You have an e-mail address where information can be sent to you.

#### What types of crimes/incidents can you report online?

- Harassing Calls, Texts & E-mails: defined as unwanted phone calls, text messages or e-mails of an annoying or harassing nature.
- Hit & Run: defined as your vehicle or property is struck by a vehicle, causing damage with no personal injury.
- Larceny / Theft: defined as your property is taken without your permission (you cannot use this online system to report stolen firearms or prescription drug offenses).
- Larceny / Theft from Auto: defined as property is stolen from within, or off of, a motor vehicle.
- Lost Property: defined as property unintentionally left behind, or property lost at an unknown time and/or location.









#### What types of crimes/incidents can you report online? (continued)

- Vandalism: defined as the act of changing, defacing, or damaging public or private property.
- Vandalism to Auto: defined as a motor vehicle is damaged or defaced.
- Supplement to a Report Already Filed: defined as you have additional information to add to a report previously filed online, over the telephone, or to a police officer (you must have a case number and officer's name in order to supplement an existing report).

Upon completing the online report, you will receive an e-mail notification that your report has been submitted. This e-mail includes a temporary report number and a copy of the temporary police report to print and to keep for your records. *Please use the system responsibly. Filing a false police report is a Class 1 misdemeanor, punishable by confinement in jail for not more than 12 months, or a fine of not more than \$2,500, or both* 

All cases filed using the Online Police Reporting System will be reviewed. Upon review, if more information regarding your case is needed, you may be contacted by the Police Department. A final confirmation with a permanent report number will be e-mailed to you. To avoid having your notification rejected as "spam" or junk mail, please add VaPrinceWilliamCountyPd@coplogic.com to your e-mail contacts list. 
#### Needle in the Haystack




#### **Early Morning** Walkers / Runners Need to Exercise Caution

Also, try not to leave your pets outdoors for extended periods of time. The cold or hot weather is dangerous to them and their barking can disturb the neighborhood.








