2012 Facilities Pass Changes

Lighting and Trash


I think that periodically it is a good thing to inform the residents of some of the issues we have in Southbridge. The following is part of an article I wrote a few years ago for the Star. It is still as valid today as it was then.

Lighting:

When Southbridge was originally laid out and the Master Plan was approved by the County, the developer was able to limit the number of street lights they installed by placing "yard lamps" in every yard. The lamps were to be controlled by photocell and were not to have a switch installed. This means they should stay lit during the hours of darkness and supplement the installed street lights, which were placed only at intersections and cul-de-sacs. Of course there is one section that has lamps along the street and they do not have the photocell controlled yard lamps, and a couple of townhome buildings were built without the photocells being installed. But the majority of homes in Southbridge have this type of light. The office routinely sends out "violation" letters to homeowners who do not have working yard lamps. These lamps are one of the primary sources of lighting in Southbridge. If you receive a letter telling you your yard lamp is not working, please replace the bulb or have it repaired. I have seen some areas where there are several houses in a row without lights. It is so much easier for vandals or other criminals to sneak around if there isn't sufficient lighting.

Trash:

The office receives many calls regarding trash on the property. Most of the calls are from Townhome sections. There is a problem with residents leaving large items out in a common area. It is not uncommon to find refrigerators, washers, or dryers sitting on common property. Another very common item is television sets or computer monitors. Residents put these out thinking that American Disposal will pick them up. They will not! If you have items other than normal trash please call American Disposal and arrange for a special pickup. As a note they will not, under any circumstances, pick up televisions or computer monitors. The Landfill has a special schedule for accepting those items and the resident needs to take them to the Prince William County Landfill themselves. If trash is left in the common areas we have our common labor person collect it and take it to the Landfill. He is paid by the hour and unless we can identify the source of the trash he is paid out of Association funds, which means you and I pay to have someone else's trash picked up. If we can identify the source of the trash the offender is billed for his hours. Please note that the Association does not pick up trash from private property, we do not pick up trash from property outside of Southbridge and we only pick up trash from common property within Southbridge (property owned by the Association).

News Desk of the PTA President of Swans Creek Elementary School:

Dear Parents and Neighbors of Swans Creek:

It has come to my attention that our kids' safety is at risk! As your PTA president, I am asking for your help. Everyday parents, caregivers and others either drop off or pick up their students at Swans Creek. Although it's your right to do so, PLEASE follow the rules. They apply to everyone! We do not want a traffic accident involving a child to occur.


*First, there should be NO parking on the school side of the street on Wayside Drive during our pick up and drop off times. (8:00am-9:00am/3:00pm-4:00pm) It creates an unsafe situation for everyone. If you want to have your student walk to meet you on Wayside Drive, (to avoid the loop procedure) they should use the cross walk and the crossing guard that is provided for you. Then they can be picked up on the opposite side of the street avoiding cars. This will also eliminate cars trying to make U-Turns on Wayside Drive. Also traffic traveling PAST the line of cars waiting to turn in to the school, has the right of way...please be cautions of this.

*Second, when entering the school property from Wayside Drive, you must come in SINGLE file and follow the loop path. There are no double lanes... it is ONE single lane of traffic. If you are in a hurry, please consider leaving your home earlier, having your child ride the bus or meet you up on Wayside Drive on the opposite side of the street.

*Third, you must follow the directions of the Swans Creek Staff and pick up or drop off where they instruct you to do so, stopping your vehicle when and where they direct you to. It is their goal to keep traffic moving in a quick yet safe manner for everyone. Also please do not drop off your children in the parking lot. If you do, they must have an adult walk them up to the front door!

*Fourth and most importantly, DO NOT use your cell phone during pick up and drop off! (Not even hands free ones) YOUR FULL attention is needed when you are in motion in your vehicle near our children. I sincerely appreciate your help in keeping our kids safe.

Please remember to turn in all those box tops! Each one is only worth ten cents...but when we all save them...they can really add up. Each year Swans Creek gets over \$500.00 in box top education funds! Send yours in today!

Kindergarten Registration Dates Set

Parents of children who will enter kindergarten next school year should make note of two important dates. Kindergarten registration will be held countrywide on Thursday, April 12 and Thursday, April 26. Parents should contact the school their child will attend for specific registration times.

When parents of children who speak or understand a language other than American English register their child, they will be asked to call one of two Central Registration sites, Coles, 703-791-2727, or Ann Ludwig, 703-491-8432, to make an appointment for an English language evaluation.

After April 27, instead of registering at their local school, English language learners will be registered and evaluated at Central Registration. Parents will need to call the Coles or Ann Ludwig sites for an appointment.

FACILITIES PASS INFORMATION

March 2, 2012

Pool Registration

Dear Homeowner:

The time has come to issue facilities passes for the 2012 season. Beginning April 16, 2012 facilities passes will be issued for the 2012 pool season. A facilities pass will be issued to all unit owners, members of their families residing in the unit, and to the designated tenants of unit owners. The homeowner must present identification (i.e. current driver's license, birth certificate, valid picture ID) to the Management Office staff at the time they submit the form. After verification of residence, the homeowner must complete and sign the Pool Use Agreement. At this time, 2012 facilities passes will be issued. If facilities passes were issued last year the 2012 facilities passes will be issued from last year's database. Hopefully this will not require each member to be present for the pass. If you are a new resident and have not yet obtained a facilities pass, you will need to complete all paperwork mentioned above and bring all members on the list to the clubhouse to have photos taken.

NOTE: Assessment accounts must be current in order to obtain passes.

If you are an offsite owner and are renting your home, you must authorize your tenants to use the facilities. All tenants must provide a copy of their lease after the Tenant Designation Form has been provided to the office by the homeowner. Homeowners must contact the office and a form will be delivered to them. All onsite owners need to only fill out the regular pool pass application not the tenant designation form.

Please note that the Association office will be closed on Monday May 28, 2012 and all Sundays. Facilities passes will ONLY be issued during hours listed above. There will be no exceptions.



CANDIDATES NEEDED FOR SOUTHBRIDGE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

One of Southbridge's governing documents, The Declaration for Southbridge on the Potomac Section 1.3 (d) (1) <u>Board of Directors states</u>:

"The Board of Directors is responsible for the management and upkeep of the property and the administration of the Association. Unless otherwise specifically provided in the Act or the Association Documents, all rights, powers, easements, obligations and duties of the Association may be performed by the Board of Directors on behalf of the Association."

Are you interested in how your community is run? Would you like to get involved and help make Southbridge the best it can be? Give some thought to what you may be able to contribute by serving on the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors is the governing authority of Southbridge. This is your opportunity to participate in the governance of your community!

The election of four Directors to the Southbridge Community Association Board of Directors, three for three year terms and one for a one year term will take place at the 2012 Annual Meeting. The official Call for Candidates will be mailed to all homeowners. Those interested in running for the Board should return the Declaration of Candidacy and a one page biographical information sheet to the Management Office no later than the close of business on April 18, 2012. The biographical information will be included in the official meeting notification package mailed to homeowners.

ELECTRONIC VOTING

Again, this year homeowners will have the ability to vote online for members of the Board of Directors during a period of time prior to the Annual Meeting which has been scheduled for May 22, 2012 at the Southbridge Swim and Racquet Club.

Registered users of the Southbridge website, with valid email addresses, will receive an email notification of the Annual Meeting including the list of candidates and procedures for online voting in addition to the usual notification sent by US Postal Service mail. Information on how to vote online will also be included in the USPS mailing. Each homeowner will receive the same access code on both email and USPS mail so that they can only vote once.

There are things that you as a homeowner can do the make the process run smoothly.

If you are not already a registered user of our website, register for the website at southbridgeva.us.

If you are a registered user insure that your email address is up to date and correct. If you have changed email addresses you have the ability to change it in your user profile. Please do not remove any street address or phone number information; this is not visible to other users as long as you have checked the "Hide from Address Book" box.

Add the domain "vote-now.com" to your spam filter "white list". This will prevent the voting information from being flagged as spam by your software.

All members of the Southbridge Community Association (homeowners) should expect to see either an email and/or a USPS mail concerning the Annual Meeting and Election of Directors by the end of April or very early in May. The mailing is required to take place the day following the "Record Date" which is tentatively set as April 18, 2012. The Record Date is the official date when the list of members is generated for the purpose of holding the election.



A package containing all the information on renting the center such as rules, rental procedures, fees, and an application can be picked up at the Management Office.








Early Morning Walkers / Runners Need to Exercise Caution

Also, try not to leave your pets outdoors for extended periods of time. The cold or hot weather is dangerous to them and their barking can disturb the neighborhood.









