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Board of Directors Message 2016 Spring Spectacular

At the 2016 Spring Spectacular, which will be held on April 30^{th,} the Southbridge HOA will be trying something new. Residents who attend the event will be issued a wrist band which will allow them to participate in the event. This is due to the fact that people have been observed walking in from neighboring communities to attend our events. The wrist band will be issued at the clubhouse after verification of residency using the Facilities (Pool) Pass.

At their November meeting, the Board of Directors released funds to the Activities Committee for the Spring Spectacular. At that time, the Board stipulated that the Committee determine a means to limit participation in the event to homeowners/residents in good standing. The Committee concluded that the most efficient way to check for residency is to use the Facilities (Pool) Passes.

Since Facilities (Pool) Passes are deactivated at the end of each pool season and reactivated before the pool opens when the homeowner fills out the Facilities (Pool) Pass application. The process is the same as in the past years, only the time frame is different. Remember, every pass must be reactivated every year. There are no exceptions.

The Facilities (Pool) Pass Application has been included in this newsletter and is available online at http://southbridgeva.us.

Please be aware that the Office will NOT be issuing Facilities (Pool) Passes on the day of the event. You must get a pass or have your existing pass reactivated before April 30, 2016 to attend the Spring Spectacular.

Board of Directors Elections

At the start of a new year, he Board starts thinking about elections. Elections for the Southbridge Board of Directors are not held until May but in January the Board must start planning for them. Our governing documents require us to appoint an "Election Committee" consisting of one Board member, who is not up for reelection, and at least two homeowners who are not on the Board. The Committee writes the election rules, setting the dates for various election milestones. They will review the applications to run for the Board and will count the ballots at the Annual Meeting in May. In order to meet the time deadlines set by our documents, the Board must appoint the Committee in January. If you would be willing to serve on the Election Committee please attend the January Board meeting. SNOW that dreaded four letter word we, as adults hate, is just around the corner. The Management Office would like to remind everyone that VDOT plows all of the public streets; these are all the streets within the Southbridge boundaries except Locust Creek Drive, Mountain Laurel Loop, Antrim Circle, Cosgrove Way, Wexford Loop, Metheny Place, Vaughn Lane, Clancy Drive, Nugent Lane, Garcia Way, Rocky Mount Lane, Kilkenny Way, Cusack Lane, Cahill Lane, Kildare Lane, and Sligo Loop. The streets listed are the streets Southbridge is responsible for. Please remember if you reside on a pipe steam that VDOT nor Southbridge will plow those. Please see the list on page 14 for further details.

Please be mindful of our elderly neighbors and assist them if you are able. Also PLEASE, when shoveling either your driveway or parking spaces, DO NOT shovel or pile the snow in the street or in front of fire hydrants. Sometimes depending on the snowfall, we may only get one pass by the plow trucks and you may be the reason a street is impassable or difficult to navigate for your fellow neighbors. Also remember to have FUN.

Also as a note if you are out shoveling please make sure that you clear the sidewalk in front of your home. This way the children walking from school or the bus stop do not have to walk in the street and possibly become injured. Please be safe and be mindful of others.

Roadway safety is our primary concern. Roads and/or areas, which are deemed unsafe due to snow or ice, will be suspended for collection. If we are unable to provide collection, services will resume as soon as it is safe to do so. 

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Facilities Registration

Dear Homeowners:

The time has come to issue facilities passes for the 2016 season. Beginning January 4, 2016 facilities passes will be issued/reactivated for the 2016 pool season. A facilities pass will be issued/reactivated to all unit owners, members of their families residing in the unit, and to the designated tenants of unit owners. The homeowner must complete the 2016 application and the Pool Use Agreement *(and also are available on the website)* in order to have new passes issued or to reactivate the passes issued in 2016. After verification of the account being in good standing, passes will be issued/reactivated. If you have facility passes from 2015, you *do not* need to have new passes made. After the completed paperwork is received, the passes can be reactivated. If you are a new resident and have not yet obtained a facilities pass, you will need to complete all paperwork mentioned above and bring all members on the list to the clubhouse to have photos taken.

NOTE: Assessment accounts must be current in order to obtain passes.

A fillable 2016 Facility Pass Application and Pool Use Agreement can be found at the Southbridge website (southbridgeva.us). After completion, the application and agreement may be dropped off at the association office, emailed (office@southbridgeva.us) or faxed (703 221 0190). If printing of new passes is not needed, the 2015 passes will be reactivated. No need to come to the association office unless new facility passes are required.

If you are an offsite owner and are renting your home, you must authorize your tenants to use the facilities. All tenants must provide a copy of their lease after the Tenant Designation Form has been provided to the office by the homeowner. Homeowners must contact the office and a form will be delivered to them via email or fax. All onsite owners need to only fill out the regular pool pass application not the tenant designation form.

Please note that the Association office will be closed on Monday February 15, 2016 and Monday May 30, 2016 and all Sundays.

Facilities passes will ONLY be issued during hours listed above. There will be no exceptions.

Trash continues to be an on going issue here in Southbridge. Please use the provided trash containers and be mindful of the placement of containers when not in use.

Below is some information about our trash service.







American Disposal Services is our waste and recycling hauler!

The following is a schedule of your pick up days:

Trash /Tuesday & Friday

Recycling/Friday

Trash Pick-Up-Acceptable trash collection is for household trash ONLY. Construction and remodeling debris is NOT household waste. Paint, stains and gas containers are NOT accepted. These items must be taken to the landfill. Special pick ups for larger items (couches, TV's and mattresses) must be called in and you MUST schedule a pick up at

703-368-0500.

Recycling-Acceptable recycling service consists of aluminum, tin, clear and colored glass, newspaper and #1 & #2 plastics.

Yard Debris Pick-Up- Consists of grass clippings, leaves and tree limbs. Grass and leaves MUST be bagged. Tree limbs MUST be no longer than 5' in length and 6" in diameter. Rocks, sod and dirt are NOT accepted.
