Springtime in Southbridge

We are making major renovations to the kitchen adding new commercial grade appliances and increasing its size. We are also adding an ADA compliant bathroom and in general bringing things up to code. It looks like the renovations will be completed before the pool opens. With the newly renovated clubhouse the room rental will be going up. The Board made a decision to have the room cleaned after each rental. This decision was made to keep the new furnishings in good condition. The cost of the cleaning will be passed along to those who rent the room by increasing the rental fee to \$250.00. The deposit will remain the same. Details will be provided to every homeowner in the form of a revised rental policy. I hope you enjoy the renovated clubhouse and will keep it in good shape if you use it. As a note, the April BOD meeting (Apr 26th) and probably the Annual Meeting (May 24th) will be held at the Montclair Community Library, 5049 Waterway Drive, Dumfries, VA 22025 due to the construction. Check with the office as the dates approach to be sure.

Depending on when you read this article, you may have already received the Call for Candidates. This year we need to elect four members to the Board of Directors, three for the normal three year term and one for a single year. The single year term is because the Board had to appoint a member due to a resignation. When this happens the appointed Director must stand for election by the homeowners for whatever is remaining on the term of the director who resigned. If you can spare some time and energy please consider running for the Board of Directors. We need people to make the decisions for the future of Southbridge. 

Parents of children who will enter kindergarten next school year should make note of two important dates. Kindergarten registration will be held countywide on Thursday, April 7 and Thursday, April 21. Parents should contact <u>the school their child will attend</u> for specific registration times.

When parents of children who speak or understand a language other than American English register their child, they will be asked to call one of two sites, Stonewall Middle Central Registration, 571.402.3800, or Ann Ludwig Central Registration, 703.491.8432, to make an appointment for an English language evaluation.

After April 23, instead of registering at their local school, English language learners will be registered and evaluated at Central Registration. Parents will need to call the Stonewall Middle or Ann Ludwig sites for an appointment.

Facilities Registration

Dear Homeowners:

The time has come to issue facilities passes for the 2016 season. Beginning January 4, 2016 facilities passes will be issued/reactivated for the 2016 pool season. A facilities pass will be issued/reactivated to all unit owners, members of their families residing in the unit, and to the designated tenants of unit owners. The homeowner must complete the 2016 application and the Pool Use Agreement *(and also are available on the website)* in order to have new passes issued or to reactivate the passes issued in 2016. After verification of the account being in good standing, passes will be issued/reactivated. If you have facility passes from 2015, you *do not* need to have new passes made. After the completed paperwork is received, the passes can be reactivated. If you are a new resident and have not yet obtained a facilities pass, you will need to complete all paperwork mentioned above and bring all members on the list to the clubhouse to have photos taken.

NOTE: Assessment accounts must be current in order to obtain passes.

A fillable 2016 Facility Pass Application and Pool Use Agreement can be found at the Southbridge website (southbridgeva.us). After completion, the application and agreement may be dropped off at the association office, emailed (office@southbridgeva.us) or faxed (703 221 0190). If printing of new passes is not needed, the 2015 passes will be reactivated. No need to come to the association office unless new facility passes are required.

If you are an offsite owner and are renting your home, you must authorize your tenants to use the facilities. All tenants must provide a copy of their lease after the Tenant Designation Form has been provided to the office by the homeowner. Homeowners must contact the office and a form will be delivered to them via email or fax. All onsite owners need to only fill out the regular pool pass application not the tenant designation form.

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
2016 Southbridge Summer Swim Team


