Tdap Immunization Required for Sixth Graders

Parents are reminded that all students entering sixth grade in Prince William County Public Schools this fall must present proof that they have had a booster dose of the tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap) vaccine before entering the sixth grade.

May 16, 2016

Experts say the Tdap booster gives adolescents added protection against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (better known as whooping cough). These potentially serious ailments are largely preventable with proper vaccination.

Children must meet all Virginia school immunization requirements. The law changed in 2014 to require Tdap vaccination of all sixth graders, including those under the age of 11. To avoid the last-minute rush before the start of school, parents should consider getting the Tdap booster for their child as soon as possible to fulfill this Virginia requirement.

Tdap boosters may be obtained from a doctor, military clinics, or the Prince William Health District, which will provide written documentation that the requirement has been met. If completed before the end of this school year, documentation should be taken to the nurse at the school where the child currently attends. The school nurse will notify the child's intended middle school that the vaccine has been received. This will ensure there will be no delay in your child's admission to middle school on their important first day of school on August 29.

Fight the Bite! Prevent Zika this Summer

Outbreaks of Zika virus infection have occurred in many parts of the world, and travel-related cases have been diagnosed in Virginia. Because the mosquitoes that can transmit the virus are found in the U.S., including Virginia, the Prince William Health District is spreading the word about how to protect yourself and your family.

The Disease: Mosquitoes can get infected with Zika virus when they bite a person who carries the virus, and then can infect other people by biting them. Four out of five people who are infected do NOT become sick. For those who do, the most common symptoms are fever, rash, joint pain and conjunctivitis (red eyes). Zika has been linked to birth defects, such as microcephaly (small head) in babies and other syndromes in a small number of patients. Prince William Health Director Dr. Alison Ansher advises, "There is no vaccine or specific treatment for Zika. So it is important that we all do our part to prevent mosquitoes by eliminating their breeding sites and protecting ourselves and our families from mosquito bites."

Prevention: To fight Zika:

1. Cover and repel. Wear long sleeves, pants, shoes and a hat. Use an [Environmental Protection Agency \(EPA\)-registered](#) repellent according to label directions.
2. Remove collected water. Remember: tip, toss and cover! Inspect your yard/grounds for any containers that can hold water and empty them. Throw it away if it is trash or cover it to prevent water from gathering.
3. Keep mosquitoes out of your home. Keep windows closed or make sure they have screens that keep mosquitoes outside.

Southbridge Swim Team Defends Division Championship

The Southbridge Swim Team looks to defend their 2015 Prince William Swim League Purple Division Championship this summer as they face off against other community teams from around the county. This marks their third divisional title in four years following wins in 2012 and 2014 as well.

In their first meet of the 2016 summer swim season, the Southbridge Seals edged the Veterans Park Marlins to notch a hard fought regular season victory against a team seeded in a higher division. This was only possible thanks to a strong team of enthusiastic swimmers ranging in age from 4 to 18.

In 2016, Southbridge is fielding its largest team to date with well over 100 competitive swimmers on the team. 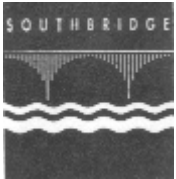
