

When you use your LEGAL fireworks use them away from your house and other houses and away from vehicles. Fireworks that project into the air can be extremely dangerous as they can land on your house or a neighbor's house. Also be mindful that the loud sounds made by fireworks can cause an uneasy feeling with many. Please be courteous and safe when using LEGAL fireworks.  INSPECTIONS- with the nice weather we will be out and about inspecting all the homes. We will be looking for power washing that may be needed at your home, mailboxes in the single-family homes that may be rusted or damaged, lamppost in your front yard without the lamp and basketball goals with torn or missing nets. Grass is always an ongoing maintenance item, please make sure you mow your grass when needed.  POOL REGISTRATION – please make sure you register for the pool prior to Memorial Day Weekend. You will need to go to southbridge.cellbadge.com The first time you are requesting approval, the second time once you get your login code you will register those who live in your household. When arriving at the pool you provide your names and address, and you will be checked in by the gate guard. The first time you come to the pool your picture will be taken.



## Summertime Recipes



### **ITALIAN CHOPPED SALAD**

A tasty side salad for an Italian dinner, or a plant-based main course for those reducing their meat consumption. Either way, it's delicious and satisfying!

### **Ingredients:**

4 cups chopped romaine lettuce

2 cups chopped tomatoes

2 cups cooked chickpeas (if canned, then drain and rinse)

1 cup sliced black olives

1 cup chopped red onion

1/4 cup chopped sun dried tomatoes (finely chopped)

2 cups chopped cucumber

1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil

1/4 cup balsamic vinegar salt and pepper to taste

#### **Instructions:**

Combine all ingredients in a large mixing bowl and toss well. Serve as a side salad or as a main meal.

### **Turkey Roll Ups**

Make your own Turkey Roll Ups at home!!

#### **Ingredients:**

8 ounces cream cheese softened

1/4 cup whole berry cranberry sauce

8 (10-inch) flour tortillas (see notes)

1/2 head romaine or green leaf lettuce torn into 4-inch pieces

16 slices deli turkey

16 slices Havarti or Swiss cheese halved

2 medium tomatoes halved and sliced

## **Instructions:**

In a small bowl, mix cream cheese with cranberry sauce until uniformly combined.

Lay one tortilla flat on a cutting board and spread a thick layer of cream cheese all the way to the edges.

Layer 3 lettuce leaves down the middle of the tortilla.

Layer two slices of turkey and 4 pieces of Swiss cheese on top of the lettuce.

Top with several slices of tomatoes.

Starting at one end of the tortilla, roll tightly towards the filling. Continue rolling until the filling is tightly wrapped and the cream cheese holds the rollup together.

Continue with the remaining tortillas until all have been assembled. Wrap each tortilla rollup tightly in plastic wrap.

Chill the wrapped rollups in the refrigerator until serving time.

To serve, trim any unfilled ends away. Slice each tortilla into 8 equal pieces.

## 2021 SOUTHBRIDGE MODIFIED POOL RULES 2021 OPENING DAY MAY 29, 2021

- 1. PROVIDE YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS TO THE GATE GUARD. ALL THOSE COMING TO THE POOL WILL BE CHECKED IN. YOUR PICTURE WILL BE TAKEN YOUR FIRST TIME CHECKING IN. A HEALTH QUESTIONAIRE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL THOSE ENTERING THE POOL ON EACH VISIT AND TEMPERATURES WILL BE TAKEN.
  - 2. NO MORE THAN 66 PEOPLE WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE WITHIN THE POOL FENCE PROXIMITY AT ONE TIME. (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

#### 3. GUESTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED

- 4. AREAS WILL BE MARKED WHERE YOU CAN SIT AND AREAS FOR THOSE IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD. LIFEGUARDS WILL DIRECT YOU TO THE PROPER AREAS WHICH MAY INCLUDE YOU SITTING AT THE LAP POOL.
- 5. THERE WILL BE NO POOL FURNITURE PLACED OUT, PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN CHAIR OR A BLANKET.
  - 6. WADING POOL AND SLIDE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON.
- 7. DIVING BOARD OPEN BUT MAY BE CLOSED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE POOL COMPANY.

  8. THERE WILL BE NO LATE NIGHT SWIMS.
  - 9. NO FOOD IS PERMITTED AT THE POOL, YOU MAY HOWEVER BRING BOTTLED WATER.

    10. DURING THE HALF HOUR BETWEEN SESSIONS, ALL PATRONS MUST LEAVE THE POOL
    - 11. NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED MORE THAN ONE SESSION PER DAY.


