2023 Pool Season The 2023 pool season is right around the corner and we are looking forward to another successful season. Please make sure you are aware of the Rules and Regulations governing the pool. These will be emailed to everyone prior to opening day and will be available at the pool. Southbridge has had a lot of success with the pool company hiring teens that live at Southbridge, if you have a teen in your house looking for a great summer job, please look in this newsletter for information on the pool company.

Events We are once again looking forward to a successful Spring Fling, Fall Festival and 3 movie nights this year with one being at the pool which always proves to be a lot of fun. We are looking forward to seeing everyone at the events and we also would like to bring back a couple game nights and possibly some painting parties. Events are a great way to network with other residents of Southbridge. And don't forget the yard sales which are always very successful.

<u>Cats</u> we are getting complaints of large groups of cats hanging out in the community. The Association is not responsible for the cats. Many residents are feeding them as we have seen food out. A few of the cats may have been spayed or neutered and ear tipped, these cats cannot be removed from the property (location) they were trapped at. Unfortunately, the shelter will not take in feral cats unless they are showing signs of illness. I believe that there are many residents moving and leaving their cats behind. I will be working with some rescue groups to see if these cats can be trapped, spayed or neutered (TNR), but they will need to be returned to the location where trapped. The good news is with the TNR program you will not see new kittens.

Inspections we will be out and about in the community soon for the yearly inspections. Take this time to access whether your house needs to be power washed, leaves and weeds that need to be cleaned up, broken mailboxes, basketball goals missing nets or laying on the ground or weighted down with buckets and other debris. Help us in making sure the community looks nice and stays competitive with other communities.

<u>Homeless Camp</u> we have received calls about the tents located in the woods behind the Southbridge sign on Route One and Wayside Drive. The police are aware of this and will be working with Social Services to address the concerns. That area is owned by a company out of New York.

<u>**Trees**</u> please remember to trim your trees, especially those that may be overhanging into your neighbors yard. Trees that do overhang can be cut by the owner of the home where the tree is hanging but it is better for the owner of the tree (s) to have them trimmed so they are kept in balance.



INSTRUCTIONS TO REGISTER

- * Log Into: southbridge.cellbadge.com/registration
- * Click on green registration "I NEED TO REGISTER"
- * You will receive an email and text that you are approved.
- * Log back in as above and request pin number.
- * Once you receive the pin number log in and enter all members of the household.
- * The office will do a final approval and you are ready to use the pool.
- * Once registered and approved, any changes are made by you and required a new pin code.
- * All tenants must be approved by their landlord before approval can be obtained, tenants will register and once verified by the homeowner they will be approved. A current lease is required.

ENTRY TO POOL

- * When you arrive at the pool, provide the gate guard with your address and they will register all those who are with you.
- * Upon your first visit to the pool the gate guard will take all the pictures as they check you in.
- * Those who are delinquent in their assessment fees, or who may have been suspended from using the pool will be blocked from entering.
- * 2 guests are permitted for each household. ID is required and the guest must sign in, Southbridge residents cannot come into the pool on a guest pass. The ID cannot have a Southbridge address.

TRASH THROUGHOUT TOWNHOMES

Trash is becoming a problem again throughout the townhomes. One person is responsible for keeping the townhome streets and islands clean but he only does the townhomes on Mondays and Thursdays as he also needs to do other common areas in Southbridge and empty 31 trashcans not within the townhomes. The alternative is to hire at least a part time person to handle the townhomes.

Please help in keeping your community clean. If you put trash bags on the ground put them out in the mornings on Monday and Tuesday only so that animals will not tear into the bags. The trash company is not responsible for picking up trash that spills from the bags. Also, please help in picking up trash on the ground and in the parking lot. One person is simply not enough manpower for the amount of trash on the property and the common areas that need to be checked.

COMPLETION OF THE REPLACEMENT OF THE TOWNHOME MAILBOXES IS SCHEDULED TO BEGIN LATE MARCH. THIS WILL BE ON ANTRIM CIRCLE AND COSGROVE WAY. THE CURRENT MAILBOXES WILL BE SET ASIDE FOR THE POST OFFICE TO USE AND CONCRETE BASES WILL BE POURED AND THE NEW BOXES MOUNTED. THE POST OFFICE MAY NOT DELIVER MAIL DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS BUT WE WILL ASK THAT THEY USE THE OLD BOXES THAT WE SET TO THE SIDE.
